Replacement/New Bylaw # & Title: APPENDIX "A" - By-Law 24: 2014 - 2015 Tuition & Mandatory Fees (Domestic Students)

- 1. Tuition & Mandatory Fees for the College will be assessed as follows:
 - I. <u>University Studies/Career Tech Programs:</u>
 - a) Course Fees (base): 100 400 Level Courses (1st to 4th year) University Studies, Business Administration, Sustainable Tourism and Recreation are calculated on the basis of \$99.93 per credit (most courses are 3 credits and have fees of \$299.79).
 - b) Lab fees for any of the above courses have tuition of \$22.95 per course credit, to a maximum of \$68.85.
 - c) Course Fees (base): 300 400 Upper Level Courses (as of 2010 Fall Term) (3rd to 4th year) University Studies and Business Administration are calculated on the basis of \$219.46 per credit (most courses are 3 credits and have fees of \$658.38).

II. Vocational Programs:

- a) Transitions: fees are calculated on the basis of \$76.00 per week of instruction.
- b) Trades and Intro to Trades: fees are calculated on the basis of \$92.12 per week of instruction.
- c) Apprenticeship: fees are calculated on the basis of \$92.12 per week of instruction.
- d) Child, Youth & Family Studies (CYFS) Certificate level courses:
 - a. Child, Youth & Family Studies (CYFS): fees are calculated at \$58.89 per credit.
 - b. Human Service Worker (HSWR): fees are calculated at \$58.89 per credit.
 - c. Early Childhood Education (ECED): fees are calculated at \$57.22 per credit.
 - d. Education Assistant (EAP): fees are calculated at \$93.11 per credit.
- e) Child, Youth & Family Studies (CYFS) Diploma level courses:
 - a. Child, Youth & Family Studies (CYFS): fees are calculated at \$357.91 per 3 credit course.
 - b. Human Service Worker (HSWR): fees are calculated at \$357.91 per 3 credit course.
 - c. Early Childhood Education (ECED): fees are calculated at \$394.13 per 3 credit course,

\$416.72 per 4 credit course, and

\$478.61 per 6 credit course.

- d. Education Assistant (EAP): fees are calculated at \$394.13 per 3 credit course.
- f) Office Administration: fees are calculated at \$99.93 per credit.
- g) Hairstylist: fees are calculated at \$96.19/week + \$165.54/term materials fee.
- h) Mountain Adventure Skills Training (MAST) Certificate level: program fees are \$9,800.00.

- i) Adventure Tourism Business Operations (ATBO):
 - a. Certificate & Diploma Fees: fees are calculated at \$99.93 per credit.
 - b. Lab Fees: fees are calculated at \$22.95 per course to a maximum of \$68.85.
 - c. Field Fees: fees are at Certificate \$290.65 & Diploma \$334.87.
 - d. Other Mandatory Fees: fees are \$272.76.

III. Health Programs:

- a) Nursing (BSN) Year 1 (based on a 34 week program): \$112.98 per week (\$3,841.32)
- b) Nursing (BSN) Year 2 (based on a 34 week program): \$112.98 per week (\$3,841.32)
- c) Nursing (BSN) Year 3 (based on a 15 week program): \$106.72 per week (\$1,600.80)
- d) Provincial Practical Nursing Program (PPNP) (based on a 2 year diploma program): \$160.19 per credit (\$11,373.49)
 - a. PPNP-101 course fees are \$78.03 per credit (\$234.09 per 3 credit).
- e) Practical Nursing Access Program (PNAP): \$160.19 per credit
- f) Health Care Assistant (HCA) (based on 27 week program): \$72.62 per week (\$1,960.74)
- g) Dental Programs (based on 40 week program): \$91.94 per week (\$3,677.60)
- IV. <u>Adult Basic Education (ABE) (upgrading) / English Language Training (ELT) Program:</u> is tuition free. Payment of other mandatory fees as contained in the College calendar is required, with percentages based on unit values.
- 2. I. Continuing Education, Cost Recovery, International Education, Selective Entry, Information Tech, Contract and Non-Credit Program fees are variable based upon the nature and cost of presenting the course and the number of hours of instruction.
 - II. Audit status students are required to pay full fees.
 - III. Co-sponsored courses and courses in which the College serves as "broker" shall have tuition fees established according to the requirements of all parties and institutions concerned in presenting the course.
 - IV. Persons 60 years of age or over:
 - a) Guaranteed seat: may register and are required to pay full fees.
 - b) Non-guaranteed seat: may register after the advertised deadline for fees owing and be entitled to free tuition and lab fees on courses other than courses falling within 2. I. above.

This applies to tuition fees and lab fees only and does not includes texts, supplies, materials or any other associated fees or costs.

- 3. In addition, the College may provide extraordinary course/program offerings on a cost recovery basis.
- 4. This fee schedule will remain in effect until further notice as provided by Bylaw amendment.
