**Articulation Agreement
Emily Carr University of Art + Design (ECUAD) and
College of the Rockies (COTR)**

Purpose:

The purpose of this agreement is to provide students enrolled in the Fine Arts Certificate Program at the College of the Rockies the opportunity to transfer into a Bachelor's degree program at Emily Carr University of Art + Design.

Terms and Conditions:

1.) Transfer to the Bachelor of Fine Arts (Visual Arts)

- a) Students who complete the Fine Arts Certificate Program at COTR with a cumulative grade point average of B (3.00) will automatically be accepted into year two (2) of the Bachelor of Fine Art (Visual Arts major) degree program at ECUAD.
- b) Students with a cumulative grade point average between 2.00 and 2.99 will be considered for admission to year two (2) of the Bachelor of Fine Arts (Visual Arts major) degree program on the basis of their academic standing and a portfolio review.

2.) Transfer to all other majors in the Bachelor of Fine Arts; Bachelor of Design and Bachelor of Media Arts degree programs

Students who complete the Fine Arts Certificate program at COTR with an average of C (2.00) or higher will be considered for admission to the above noted programs on the basis of their academic standing and a portfolio review.

3.) Credit Assignment and Deficiencies

COTR Fine Arts Certificate students are strongly advised to complete the following 30 credits within the Fine Arts Certificate program in order to be considered for admission into year two (2) of the Bachelor of Fine Arts (Visual Arts major) at ECUAD with no deficiencies:

ENGL 100 (3 credits) and ENGL 101 (3 credits) or ENGL 102 (3 credits), FA 100 (3 credits) and FA 101 (3 credits)

18 credits from: FA 103; FA 105; FA 106; FA 107; FA 108; FA 208; FA 213; FA 217; FA 218 and FA 219

The following courses completed at COTR under the Fine Arts Certificate Program prior to September 1, 2021 will also be considered for transfer credit towards admission into the Bachelor of Fine Arts (Visual Arts major) at ECUAD: ACT 100, FA 215 and FA 220.

COTR students completing an alternate Certificate curriculum will be considered for admission however, they will be required to make up any Foundation (First Year) deficiencies at ECUAD.

Terms of Agreement:

This agreement is in effect as of September 1, 2021. The terms and conditions of the agreement, and the continuation of the agreement, will be reviewed annually by both parties.
