MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING REGARDING BLOCK TRANSFER



College of the Rockies Cranbrook, BC

and

Board of Governors of Bow Valley College Calgary, AB



This memorandum of understanding constitutes an agreement between Bow Valley College and College of the Rockies.

Objective of the Agreement:

College of the Rockies (COTR) agrees to facilitate the block transfer of students from Bow Valley College (BVC) Business Administration Diploma-Accounting major, Integrated Marketing Communications major, General Business major and Financial major programs into the 120 credit COTR Bachelor of Business Administration in Sustainable Business Practices degree. By this agreement, applicants from Bow Valley College who meet the requirements outlined below will be eligible for admission to COTR with full block transfer, provided all other entrance criteria are met and space remains available in the Bachelor of Business Administration in Sustainable Business Practices degree.

Terms of Agreement

 - o (Appendix B- Integrated Marketing Communications Major Diploma)
 - o (Appendix C- General Business Major Diploma)
 - (Appendix D- Financial Major Diploma)

As a partner to this agreement, Bow Valley College agrees:

- To provide opportunity for representatives of COTR to visit appropriate forums at BVC to disseminate information about this degree program and other unique COTR programs;
- To notify COTR when changes are made to the Business Administration Diploma programs curriculum; and
- To provide COTR with updated information about the BVC programs on an annual basis.

As a partner to the agreement, College of the Rockies agrees:

- To provide students holding an Accounting, Integrated Marketing Communications, General Business or Financial Diplomas from BVC with academic acceptance into the Bachelor of Business Administration in Sustainable Business Practices degree at COTR;
- Whenever possible, to count any undefined transfer credits towards the Bachelor of Business Administration in Sustainable Business Practices degree requirements to minimize the need to take additional courses to qualify for graduation; and
- To provide BVC with annual updates on the COTR programs.

Provisions

• This transfer agreement features guaranteed admission into the 3rd year of the Bachelor of Business in Sustainable Business Practices degree for students who have successfully completed all of the courses in the agreement with a Bow Valley College GPA of 2.33 (C+) with a minimum grade of C on transferred courses.

Exchange of Information:

Both parties will update the other with respect to changes in their courses and programs that are anticipated or approved.

Both parties agree to make information about this arrangement available to their respective relevant institutional departments and students.

Implementation of this agreement will be through the Registrar's Office at each institution, in consultation with the appropriate authorities in the respective programs.

Duration and Termination of the Agreement

This agreement shall be in place for a period of three years commencing January 1, 2022. At the end of this time, the agreement will be subject to review and renewal by the parties. Each partner will notify the other transfer partner of any impediments, with the goal of negotiating a new agreement. Final approval of the agreement will remain with the President of College of the Rockies.

This MOU may be terminated by either Party by giving written notice of its intention at least eight months prior to termination.
