Degree requirements at the University of Lethbridge

- General Liberal Education Requirement (GLER)
 - All students at the U of L, regardless of program, must complete the following:
 - 4 courses from the Humanities/Fine Arts list
 - 4 courses from the Social Sciences list
 - 4 courses from the Sciences list
- For 40-course degree programs (e.g. B.A., B.Sc.), students may complete a maximum of 12 courses at the 1000 level
- For 50-course Combined Degrees programs (e.g. B.A./B.Mgt., B.Sc./B.Ed., etc.) students may complete a maximum of 10 courses at the 1000 level

In consideration of these U of L degree requirements, the above table provides information pertinent to course selection.

Admission requirements at the University of Lethbridge

- Students completing the Environmental Studies Certificate at the College of the Rockies will apply to the U of L as transfer applicants, and will be admissible with a minimum GPA of 2.00 (calculated on all transfer courses)
- Students applying to the B.Sc. (Environmental Science) also need to provide proof of completion of Biology 12, Chemistry 12, and Pre-Calculus 12 (or university-level equivalents)
